

## Respironics EverGo and Major Commercial Airlines

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has approved the **Respironics EverGo** portable oxygen concentrator for use aboard commercial airline flights traveling within the United States as well as on international flights that begin or end in the United States. Because airline policies for traveling with an oxygen concentrator vary, patients need to check with their airlines before flying with the EverGo. The “FAA-approved” label is located on the top of the EverGo device above the touch screen. To view the label, unzip the EverGo case and open the top flap. Below is a list of major commercial airlines in the United States that allow EverGo Concentrator onboard.
