

Invacare XPO2 and Major Commercial Airlines

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has approved the **Invacare XPO2** portable oxygen concentrator for use aboard commercial airline flights traveling within the United States as well as on international flights that begin or end in the United States. Because airline policies for traveling with an oxygen concentrator vary, patients need to check with their airline before making arrangements for travel.
