

## Installation and Use Instructions

### **TL-2700 Motion Sensing Exit Alarm**

#### TL-2700 Motion Sensor

The TL-2700 Motion Sensing Exit Alarm is extremely easy to use and install. With a range of 30 feet (depending on the environment) this compact wireless unit alerts caregiver when a resident vacates a bed, chair or the caregivers designated area. When the Motion Sensing Exit Alarm is triggered an alarm will immediately sound. An extendable mounting bracket is available to help eliminate false alarms. The Motion Sensor comes with a 90 day warranty.



IMPORTANT OPERATIONAL WARNING: The alarm will sound until sensor is turned off or reset. Once the alert sounds, it is important to check on the resident IMMEDIATELY.



### 1 How to Activate


- Remove sensor from bracket by gently lifting the bracket over the square pegs. See diagram.
- Insert 9V battery (not included) into battery compartment.(See diagram)
- Close the battery cover and put the bracket back on and wait 10 seconds before use.






**2** Adjust Settings

- The chime mode sounds like a doorbell.
- The second setting is OFF mode.
- Please note that the monitor will be shipped with the alarm volume set at 90 decibels per foot (90 decibels is the legally accepted occupational noise allowance).
- Slide switch to off to reset the alarm.



# **3** Sensor Placement

- Mount exit alarm in the desired monitoring area such as residents bedside, chair side or doorway. Make sure the resident cannot tamper with the monitor.
- When installed correctly the unit has a detection coverage of approximately 30 feet (depending on the environment).
- Test all settings before using.



# **4** Exit Alarm Maintenance

- Do not disassemble the main unit.
- Do not install unit in direct sunlight or rain. Avoid places where a drastic change of temperature may occur.
- Do not install unit near heat sources such as stove tops, fans, radiators or illuminators.
- Do not stab or poke lens or speaker.
- Remove battery when not in use for more than a week.
