## Sizing guide

In order to help provide patient comfort and maximum absorbency, selecting the right size is important. You can determine the proper size by either using a measuring tape or using the patients' height and weight.
McKesson provides complimentary sizing and application kits that contain:

- Measuring tape color coded by size
- Sizing charts
- Application video and written guide


## Using a measuring tape:

(1) Measure the patient from hip to hip and multiply by 2 and add 2 inches.
(2) Once you have the total hip measurement, you will want to use the McKesson sizing chart and determine the proper size based on the product you are using.

$$
\begin{gathered}
\text { Hip bone to hip bone = } 19 \text { " }(49 \mathrm{~cm}) \\
19^{\prime \prime} \times 2(49 \mathrm{~cm} \mathrm{x} 2)=38^{\prime \prime}(96.5 \mathrm{~cm}) \\
38^{\prime \prime}+2 "(97 \mathrm{~cm}+5 \mathrm{~cm})=40^{\prime \prime}(102 \mathrm{~cm}) \\
40^{\prime \prime}(102 \mathrm{~cm})=\text { Medium or Regular brief }
\end{gathered}
$$

## Using the patients' height and weight:

You will need to use the McKesson sizing chart. For example, if the patient is $5^{\prime} 5$ " and 140 pounds, then you would select a size Medium. See sizing charts on pages 13-14.
