Plug the External Battery Charger AC power supply cord into the nearest electrical outlet.

Plug the External Battery Charger AC power supply into the battery charger.



Slide your charger onto the Inogen One G2 Battery by clicking and locking into the charger.



When the battery is in the correct position, a solid red light will indicate that the battery is charging.



When the green light illuminates, the battery is fully charged.*

*If the red power light is flashing, unplug the unit and complete steps 2-3 again. If a red flashing light continues after repeating these steps, contact your Equipment Provider.
