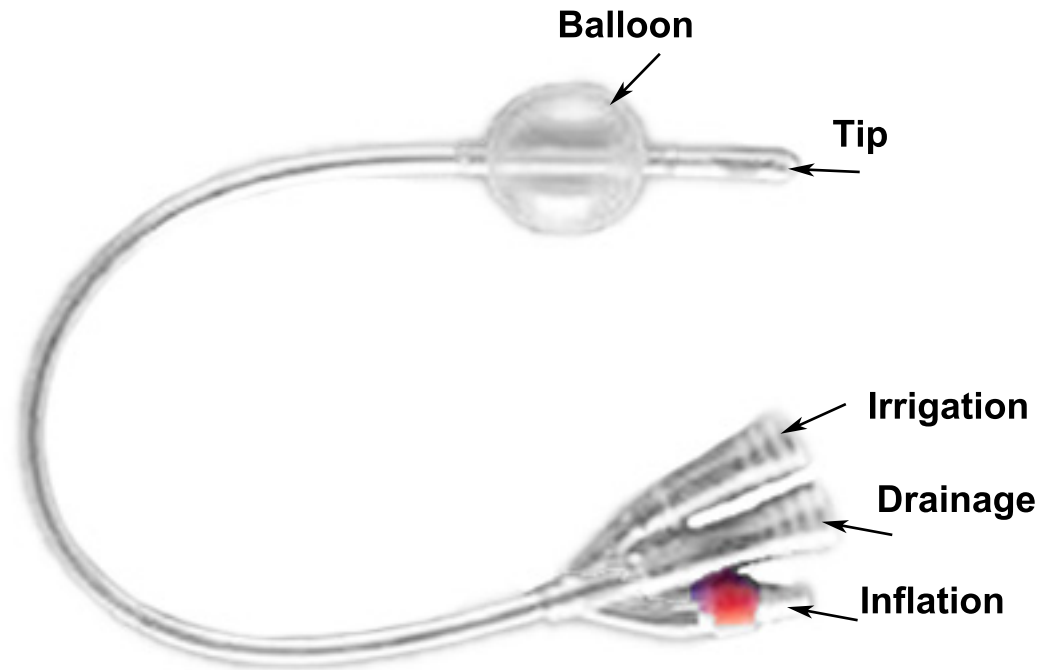


# Anatomy of a Catheter



## Foley Catheter (3-Way)

- Foley catheters are indwelling catheters held in place in the bladder by an inflatable balloon.
- 2 Way Foley catheters are the most common that have drainage and inflation.
- 3 Way Foley catheters have an additional port for irrigation.
- Typical balloon sizes range from 5 cc to 30 cc.
