PrimaFit is an external urine management system designed to help manage urinary incontinence in patients with female anatomy and promote early catheter removal, addressing the #1 risk factor of catheter-associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI). PrimaFit serves as an alternative to incontinence pads, diapers, or, at times, catheters while transitioning patients to independent continence.

When properly positioned, PrimaFit's ultra-soft fabric diverts urine away from the patient's skin. Urine is then absorbed into the system's core and suctioned into a collection canister, helping keep the skin dry and addressing a risk factor or incontinence-associated dermatitis (IAD).
