#### WHAT IS OSTEOARTHRITIS?

Osteoarthritis (OA), also known as degenerative arthritis, degenerative joint disease, or osteoarthrosis, is the most common joint disorder caused by aging and wear and tear on a joint.

#### WHAT CAUSES OSTEOARTHRITIS?

Osteoarthritis is mostly related to aging. The water content of the cartilage increases and protein makeup of cartilage degenerates. Repetitive use of the joints over the years causes damage to the cartilage that leads to joint pain and swelling. Also, it may be caused by another disease or condition. Conditions that can lead to osteoarthritis include obesity, repeated trauma or surgery to the joint structure, fractures, diabetes, and other hormone disorders.

#### THE SYMPTOMS OF OSTEOARTHRITIS

The symptoms of osteoarthritis vary from person to person. Restricted movement caused by joint degeneration, pain and stiffness in the joints are the most common symptoms.

#### TREATING OSTEOARTHRITIS NATURALLY

Doctors have many medications that can help you deal with osteoarthritis pain but there are also natural remedies you can use:

- ✓ EXERCISING gentle weight training and aerobic exercise can strengthen the muscles around the affected joint, providing it with greater support. Also, aquatic exercise is one of the natural remedies that have been shown to help.
- ✓ WEIGHT CONTROL if you are overweight, you are putting a lot of pressure, stress, and strain on knees and hips, worsening osteoarthritis pain. Eating a balanced diet and exercising helps to keep your weight under control.
- ✓ BRACES can help in relieving pain for weakened joints by adding support and promoting proper movement. Braces and splints should be used only if recommended by a healthcare professional.

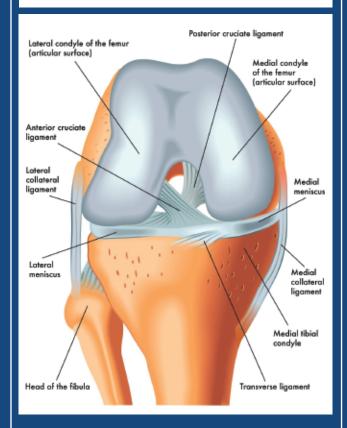
