Do You Know the Source of the Alcohol In Your Hand Sanitizer?

Alcohol in hand sanitizers should be of the highest quality (USP-grade) and traceable to the source of production. It should be from one reliable source (not blended) and without contaminants. Because skin is a critical barrier protecting the body from the invasion of toxic substances and pathogens, its health must be maintained. In fact, the products we put on our skin can have a significant effect on overall health and should be of the highest quality and reliability.

The alcohol (ethanol) that McCord Health uses in their hand sanitizer is produced from one source: corn grown on Iowa and Illinois farms. The alcohol is produced at an Iowa company that has been making USP-grade alcohol since 1943 when the soldiers needed it during WWII. In fact, this company is one of the five largest USP-grade alcohol producers in the world. It's not fuel alcohol and it's not blended so it is completely traceable. The hand sanitizer is also made by one manufacturer (no co-packing) and all the components are easily traceable.

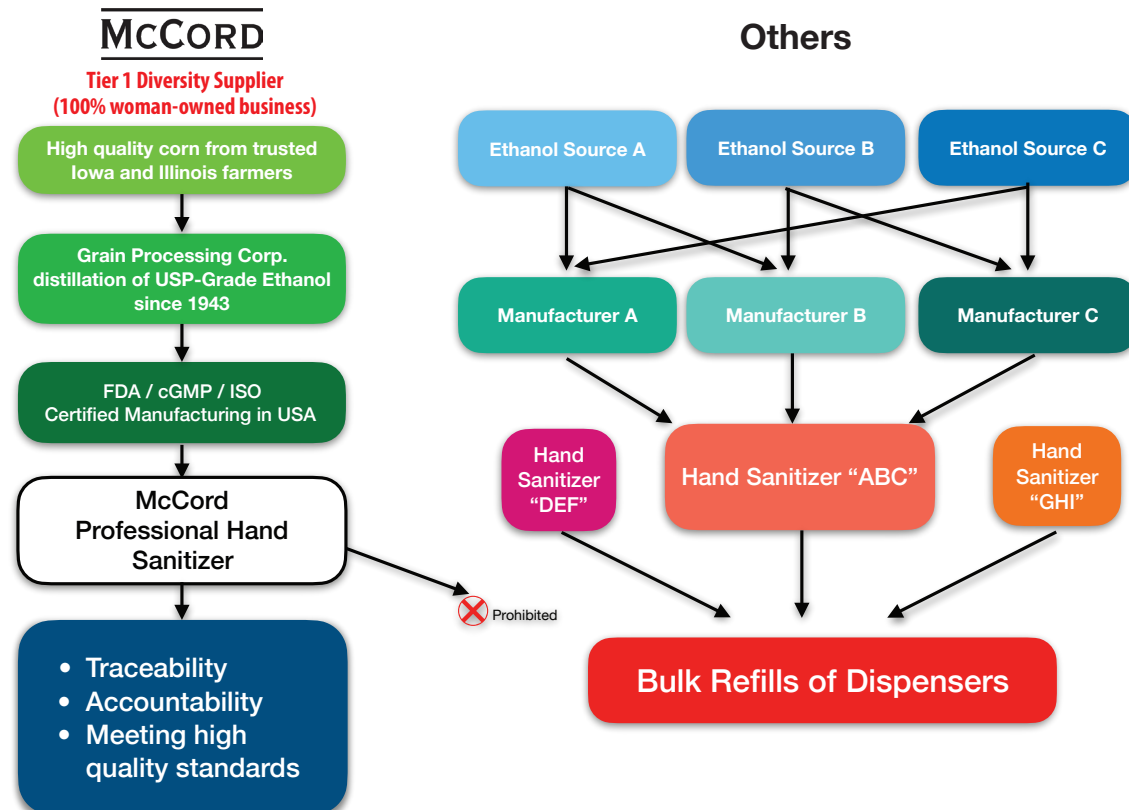
Every day you hear about more hand sanitizers being recalled by the FDA due to alcohol that is contaminated, of low-grade blends or made from fuel

that puts the users in danger and can't be traced to the source if an adverse event and health issue occurs. Besides the quality of the alcohol, hand sanitizers must have high quality components that keep skin from breaking down, increasing the risk of disease. Skin is naturally acidic (has a protective low pH). Hand sanitizers with high pH due to thickening agents can result in dermatitis and other adverse skin issues.

Hand sanitizer products that are in known batches (with specific Lot Numbers) placed directly in dispensers are safe and traceable. Refilling dispensers encourages watering down, contaminating or blending with other products during refills, putting users at risk for hand contamination and disease. It's difficult to stop this process (since it may not be known) and find the source when this happens.

McCord Health knows the source of their ingredients down to the corn farmers and processors who have been making quality alcohol for over 80 years. We use only the highest quality ingredients in our hand sanitizers including USP-grade alcohol so users never have to worry about health issues from toxins or contaminants.
