

# LiquiBand®

## Patient Guidance Sheet

Your wound has been repaired using LiquiBand® topical skin adhesive. The list below is to serve as a guide for you to understand and care for your wound following your procedure.

- The LiquiBand® skin adhesive has been applied to close your wound.
- Your wound will have the appearance of a dry scab and should be treated accordingly. You should not rub, scratch or pick at the wound. Doing so may compromise the integrity of the wound closure. The adhesive will flake off as the initial wound healing takes place.
- You should keep your wound clean and dry. Light showering is permitted.
- Although not necessary, you may apply a dry dressing to cover your wound. Do not place tape directly over the wound.
- Do not apply barrier creams, petroleum jelly or mineral oils to your wound as this, too, may compromise the integrity of the wound closure.
- If the appearance of your wound changes or becomes painful, or if you have any concerns, please contact your medical professional.
- Keep your wound protected from injury during the healing period.
- The LiquiBand® skin adhesive will naturally slough off completely between 5 and 10 days after the procedure. By this time, your wound should be sufficiently healed.

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
